Geriatrics Associates, PC is an organization of dedicated and compassionate physicians, physician assistants, and nurse practitioners committed to providing quality care to their residents and patients. We also serve those who have chosen hospice in either their home, nursing home or assisted-living facility.

Our goal is to provide primary care to our residents and patients as either a bridge between their hospitalization and eventual return to their home setting or, if necessary, to provide long-term care for those who cannot return home. The patients receiving therapy and short-term care after a hospitalization are referred to by Medicare as skilled patients; those receiving long-term care are referred to as non-skilled residents.

In addition to providing care for residents in the skilled and non-skilled setting, we also support hospice and palliative care for those residents seeking quality-of-life and comfort over endless procedures and repeated hospitalizations. Relieving pain and suffering at the end of life in either the nursing home, assisted-living facility or home where they live is one of our primary goals. And, there are many available treatment modalities to allow those choosing palliative care and hospice to be comfortable and pain-free.

Knowing that you have a choice of providers, we strive to be available and accessible to you, whether you are in your own home, or in the long-term care facilities that we serve.

Philosophy

Geriatrics Associates, PC occupies a unique position in the healthcare community. We provide a similar service to nursing homes that hospitalists provide to hospitals. Hospitalists are family physicians and internists that care for hospitalized patients. Many primary care and specialty physicians choose to remain in their offices and clinics to be more available to their patients. In years past these primary care physicians saw patients not only in their clinics, but also in the hospitals and long-term care settings. However, as the number of primary care physicians has diminished, they concentrate on their clinic practice and forego the daunting challenge of providing services in all areas.

Our role in the healthcare community is to become the "hospitalists" for the long-term care population. Therefore, we do not work in a clinic or have traditional "office hours" to see our patients. We go to our patients in all 17 of the long-term care facilities in Albuquerque. This allows us to be available during the entire day rather than for an hour or two before and/or after a busy clinic practice. We practice full-time in our long-term care community. This service has been met with extraordinary applause from healthcare leaders as a concept long overdue given the increasing complexity and acuity of patients in the nursing homes and rehabilitation centers in Albuquerque.
